SEIU reserves the right to add, modify, and delete to the following proposal.

**Bi-lingual Pay** 

- A. The County agrees to pay \$5025.00 per pay period for those pay periods in which an eligible employee is assigned to a designated position requiring verbal bi-lingual abilities, and \$100.0050.00 per pay period for those pay periods in which an eligible employee is assigned to a designated position requiring written bi-lingual abilities.
- B. Employees that are known to possess bi-lingual skills but who are not receiving bi-lingual pay will not normally be called upon to use their skill, except when circumstances prevent the use of a dcsigna'tcd bi-lingual employee. Ir a non-designated employee is frequently called upon to provide bi-lingual service, the department head will consider designating the position as bi-lingual.
- C. Effective July I, 2022. the County will establish its own bi-lingual certification program with the Human Resources Division. Existing employees seeking bi-lingual certification will have testing priority over non-employees. Employees shall be able to test once annually for bi-lingual certification through the County program on paid County time. <u>SEIU and Kern County will meet and confer over testing requirements.</u>
- D. The following languages are considered threshold language(s) for the County and are eligible for bi-lingual pay:
- Spanish
- American Sign Language
- Tagalog
- <u>Punjabi</u>

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E. If additional threshold languages are added, the County and the Union agree to meet within 30 days to discuss expanding this Article to include additional languages eligible for bi-lingual pay.
